10/12 (This 6- month age range could potentially play U10 or U12 depending on player/ team numbers.)

Under 10: 7/1/13 - 6/30/15 Under 8: 7/1/15 - 6/30/17 Under 6: 7/1/17 - 6/30/19 Pee Wee: 7/1/19 - 6/30/20

(Pee Wee is only offered in the Spring.)

In accordance to club guidelines, players will be assigned the appropriate age group during the registration process.

Payment is required for the two oldest siblings, the third and additional siblings (attach another copy) are <u>FREE</u>.

"Playing Up" an age group is rare and not recommended. Players must be in their last eligible age group season (spring), meet certain criteria, and request to "play up" in writing. They will be processed individually.

Pee Wee Clinic is only offered in the spring season.

Parents Please Note:

All U6 and U8 games are played on Saturdays, U10 games are played on Sundays. All games are at Spider lake. U12 and U14 games are Sunday Afternoons with some games at Spider Lake and some games at other local clubs in the area. (Brockway, Brookville, Clearfield, Reynoldsville, St Marys etc.)

VOLUNTEER INFORMATION

DuBois Soccer Association is a volunteer organization and appreciates every effort to assist our mission, especially hours donated by our parents and guardians. Recreation leagues are organized as a fun activity and prior soccer knowledge is **not** a requirement. Experienced coaches are available to answer all your questions.

In accordance with PA State Laws, coaches are required to apply and pass four on-line child safety clearances. The clearances are fully transferable to other organizations (such as PTAs, youth groups, scouting, etc).

SEASON INFORMATION

Volunteer head coaches determine the practice schedule and typically practice once or twice a week for at least an hour. Every team's practice schedule is determined by the head coach primarily based on their availability.

Most age groups play Saturday mornings between 9 AM and 12 PM at Spider Lake. U10 plays on Sundays in the Fall season only. Depending on the level of player interest, older age groups (U12 and up) often partner with neighboring clubs and games will include limited travel.

Pee Wee Soccer (only available in the Spring) is a Weekly Clinic for 4 year olds. Pee Wees meet once a week on Saturdays at noon for a 1 hour introduction to soccer for 5 weeks (nothing during the week). This is for kids who have turned 4 but not yet 4 ½ years old to join U6.

FEE ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

The DuBois Rotary Club and the DuBois Soccer Association together provide money to needy families for soccer registration fees. If you feel you need financial assistance, please call to discuss your situation. This will work on a sliding scale; depending on family situation and income, you may pay a partial fee or none at all.
