Team Packet

Teams must send in team registration form and fee by
March 1st to be scheduled.

Turn in Roster and Medical Release Form the day of tournament.

Age Groups:

- **FOR HS DIVISIONS ONLY – ALL PLAYERS MUST PLAY/HAVE PLAYED ON SAME HS TEAM DURING THE FALL SEASON**
- Divisions will be Junior (grade 5-6) Girls and Boys, Middle School (grade 7-8) Girls and Boys, and High School (grade 9-12 => NO out of high school players) Girls and Boys
- Coed teams will play in the Boys bracket for that age group
- Players may only be registered on, and play on, one team per age/gender bracket
- All games and playoffs will be played on the same day for each specific age group.
- Must have 4 teams in age group to compete. Middle School and Junior divisions without enough teams will have the choice of moving up, or moving to co-ed division, or having entry fee refunded. HS teams will have entry fee refunded if not enough teams in bracket to compete.

Entry Fee:

The entry fee is \$200 per team, non-refundable if bracket is held, and due with team registration form by March 1st, made payable to DuBois Soccer Association and mailed to:

Proof of Age:

Each participant must have available on day of tournament paperwork (ie last report card) to prove current grade attending in case of dispute. These will not be collected.

Additional Info:

Play is Futsal 5v5 (4 field players and keeper) – HS Boys will be 4v4 - on a full-sized basketball court with out-of-bounds lines. No usage of walls at all. Players must wear tennis shoes/indoor soccer shoes - no spikes will be permitted. **Shin guards are required. NO JEWELRY.** Teams will play at least three round robin games and then top teams will have playoff game(s). Games are 24 minutes in length with a running clock. During round robin play - wins are 3 points, ties are 1 point, and losses are 0 points. In the playoffs for games that are tied after regulation time, we will use the golden goal (sudden victory) format going to fewer players. Play is sub on the fly (hockey substitution) with no stoppage of play. Additional rules are on the rules sheet contained in this packet.

2026 DuBois Soccer Association March Mayhem Indoor Futsal Tournament Instructions to Refs and Coaches

- All coaches should show up at least 30 minutes prior to their first scheduled game. Age group coaches meetings will take place 20 minutes prior to the first games of any age groups.
- Please have each player bring an alternate colored jersey in the instance that two teams are matched up and wearing the same color. Home team will be required to change color.
- Waivers/Medical Releases must be signed in order for players to participate and must be turned in before the first game.
- To keep the tournament running smoothly and in a timely manner, it is absolutely critical that all games start at their scheduled time – please show up on time for your games.
- Tournament is a Futsal Tournament which will use a regulation basketball court as the field. Court lines will be out of bounds like outdoors. No playing off the walls at all. Futsal balls will be used.
- All play is 5v5 with sub on the fly. **HS BOYS DIVISION WILL BE 4v4**. Players need to be completely out of the play and within ten feet of the sideline before a sub enters the field – Referees will be watching this so that no unfair advantage is had.
- Each game will be 24 minutes in length with a running clock. Referee may stop the clock at their discretion due to injury, time wasting, etc.
- Team listed first will be home team and have the kickoff.
- There will be no throw-ins - it will be a kick-in from the sideline. Defenders must give 6 feet. Players cannot score directly from the sideline kick-in (it is an indirect kick). Restart is other team getting the ball at the same spot on the sideline. Corner kicks are indirect also.
- Players cannot score until they are in the attacking half of the field. Restart is a goal kick.
- Players cannot shoot at the goal on the kickoff. The ball must be played out of the center circle before a shot at the goal can be taken. (Restart is just a retake of the kickoff from the center circle by the same team).
- There are no goal kicks. Plays resulting in a goal kick will be a “Goalie Throw-in” which may be distributed anywhere on the field except into the opposing team's goal area on the fly. The “Goalie Throw-in” can be taken from anywhere within their own goal area.
- Goalies may distribute the ball past midfield by any method upon making a save. Goalies are not permitted to throw/kick the ball directly into the opposing team’s goal area on the fly after making a save. Goalies cannot score directly from a throw/kick from within their own goal area.
- Balls played to the goalie will be treated the same as outdoor rules.
- All kicks for fouls will follow FIFA rules for directs and indirects. Except for penalties in the box which will result in a PK from the top of the goalie box.
- No sliding permitted by field players. Goalies may slide tackle inside the goal box only.
- Limit of three coaches on sideline – to be enforced by the referees.
- **NO OFFSIDES WILL BE CALLED.**
- A win will count as three (3) points, a tie as one (1) point, and a loss as zero (0) points.
- In playoffs, teams tied at the end of regulation will go to golden goal sudden victory, beginning with 5v5 (4v4 for HS Boys) for 3 minutes with a new kickoff from the center with the first team listed kicking off. Then moving to 4v4 (3v3 for HS boys) for 3 minutes with the team listed second kicking off. Then moving to 3v3 (2v2 for HS Boys) **WITHOUT A KEEPER** with a drop ball in the center circle to start and playing until a goal scored.
- A red card issued to a player or coach will result in disqualification for the entire tournament.
- A yellow-carded player needs to leave the field immediately and sit for 2 minutes, but may be substituted for as the game continues. After 2 minutes, the player can return to being subbed as normal. Two Yellow Cards in one game or Three Yellow Cards throughout the day will result in a red card and disqualification for the rest of the tournament.
- All referee decisions are final and cannot be contested – Please do not challenge referees calls during or after any game.
- Places determined by record. Tiebreakers will consist of (in this order): head to head if only two teams tied (If more than two teams are tied this will be skipped and will move directly to goal differential criteria and so on until teams are eliminated and only two remain. Once two teams remain we will start again at head to head with these two teams only), goal differential (max 5 per game), goals allowed (max 5 per game), goals scored (max 5 per game), 3 player PK shootout.
