Age Groups: Divisions will be:

Girls: U-11, U-13, U-15, High School and Adult Women's Open Boys or (Coed): U-11, U-13, U-15, and High School

We have adopted the new Calendar Year age groups directed by PA West and USSF There must be at least 4 teams in age groupl to complete. Girls' divisions without enough will have the choice of moving up or switching to boys' division. Boy's teams must move up. Options of having a refund sent if not enough teams in a bracket to compete. After we receive 8 teams in an age group we will not add a 9th team until we get a 10th and don't add an 11th until we get a 12th team.

Entry Fee:

Proof of Age:

Each participant must have by day of tournament current player pass (PA West, US Club, or AYSO), photocopy of birth certificate, driver's license, or passport.

Additional Info:

Play will be 7v7 across half of a full size field (Boys HS division is played 6v6). Teams will play at least 3 round robin games and then top teams will have playoff game(s). Games are two 12-minute halves, with a 1 minute half-time. During round robin – wins are 3 points, ties are 1 point, and losses are 0 points. In playoffs, we will use the golden goal (sudden death) format with fewer players. Play is sub on the fly with no stoppage of play. All games and playoffs will be played the same day.

DSA 7v7 Summer Shootout Instruction to Refs and Coaches

- All Coaches should show up at least 45 minutes prior to their first scheduled game. Coaches meetings will take place 15 minutes prior the the first games of an age group. You may attend any coaches meeting.
- Coaches are not required to have clearances, but if coaches don't have clearances then there must be two coaches with the team at all times and if there are any girls on the team then one of the coaches must be a female coach.
- Please have each player bring an alternate colored jersey in the instance that two teams are matched up and wearing the same color. (Alternate jersey can just be same colored shirts with no numbers)
- > Waivers/Medical Releases must be signed for kids to participate and must be turned in before the first game.
- Players turned in on your roster are the only ones eligible to play, teams cannot trade players or use other teams' players unless same gender.
- Players can play on 2 different teams in different age groups or different gender but not on 2 teams in the same age group and same gender.
- Players can move up 1 age group without a move up form. Eights graders can play on High School teams. No one can move up 2 age groups. (no 7th graders on High School teams)
- To keep the tournament running smoothly and in a timely manner, it is absolutely critical that all games start at their scheduled time please show up on time for your games.
- Have your kids warmed up on the sidelines ready to play when you walk onto the fields.
- All play is 7v7 with sub on the fly (Exception: HS Boys will be 6v6). Players need to be completely out of the play and within ten feet of sideline before a sub enters the field.
- > Each game will consist of two 12-minute halves, with a 1-minute half-time interval.
- Team listed first will have first half kickoff. Teams switch ends of the fields at half, and the team listed second will have second half kickoff.
- Limit of three coaches on sideline to be enforced by referees.
- A player cannot shoot at the goal until the ball is played out of the center circle. (restart is just a restart of the play at the center circle by the same team)
- > NO OFFSIDE WILL BE CALLED. We will NOT use the Build Out Line for U-11.
- > PA West rules state that U-11 age groups may not head the ball at all. (restart is indirect for other team)
- Keepers May Not distribute the ball past midfield by any method unless they are playing as a field player and dribble the ball completely outside the penalty area. Keepers cannot drop the ball out fo the box and then kick it past midfield. They must dribble it out which means they must touch the ball twice to kick it past midfield. (Violations will result in possession going to the other team at midfield)
- > Goal kicks by any player also may not pass the midfield stripe. (restart at midfield by other team)
- > You can only score from your attacking half of the field.
- > No added time unless refs feel that time is being purposely wasted or for excessive long injury time.
- > A win will count as three points, a tie as one point, and a loss as zero points. (Round robin games can end in a tie)
- At the end of a round robin play to determine placement, team tiebreakers will consist of (in this order): head to head, goal differential (max 3), fewer goals allowed, goals scored (max 5 per game counted), coin toss.
- Three team tiebreaker rules skip head to head and go straight to goal differential (max 3), fewer goals allowed, goals scored (max 5 per game counted), coin toss
- In playoffs, teams tied at the end of regulation will go to golden goal sudden death, beginning with six on six and for 3 minutes with the team listed second kicking off, then moving to four on four without a keeper with the start of drop ball in the center circle going at 4v4 until a goal is scored.
- A red card issued to a player will result in disqualification for the entire tournament and the team playing down one player for the rest of that game.
- A yellow carded player needs to leave the field immediately and be substituted. Player cannot return for at least 2 game minutes and then can be subbed as normal. Coaches will be on their honor to abide by the two-minute hold, refs won't be timing.
- > Three yellow cards throughout the day will result in disqualification for the rest of the tournament.
- Referees will turn in scorecards to the registration table at the end of each game with scores and cards.
- > All referee decisions are final and cannot be contested please do not challenge calls during or after any game.
- Please note and tell your parents that there is a \$2 parking charge per vehicle.
- Concession stand will be open and first aid kit will be available there.
- > Any issues should be brought to any of the tournament staff.
