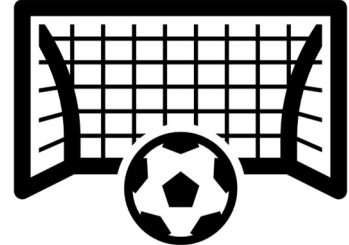

Turn in Roster and Medical Release Form the day of the tournament

Age Groups:

Divisions will be: Girls: U-11, U-13, U-15, High School and Adult Women's Open
Boys or (Coed): U-11, U-13, U-15, and High School

We have adopted the new Calendar Year age groups directed by PA West and USSF

There must be at least 4 teams in age group to complete. Girls' divisions without enough will have the choice of moving up or switching to boys' division. Boy's teams must move up. Options of having a refund sent if not enough teams in a bracket to compete.

Proof of Age:

Each participant must have by day of tournament current player pass (PA West, US Club, or AYSO), photocopy of birth certificate, driver's license, or passport.

Additional Info:

Play will be 7v7 across half of a full size field (Boys HS division is played 6v6). Teams will play at least 3 round robin games and then top teams will have playoff game(s). Games are two 12-minute halves, with a 1 minute half-time. During round robin – wins are 3 points, ties are 1 point, and losses are 0 points. In playoffs, we will use the golden goal (sudden death) format with fewer players. Play is sub on the fly with no stoppage of play. All games and playoffs will be played the same day.

7v7 Summer Shootout Rules

Instructions to Refs and Coaches

- Coaches meetings will occur 20 minutes prior to the start of each age group.
- Coaches are not required to have clearances, however if they do not have clearances there must be two coaches with the team at all times.
- Please have players bring alternate jerseys (alternate jerseys can just be different colored shirts with no numbers).
- The players on the roster are the only players who can play on that team.
- Players can play on 2 different teams in different age groups or different gender but not on 2 teams in the same age group and same gender.
- Players can move up 1 age group (i.e. 8th graders can play on HS teams) **NO** 7th graders can play in HS bracket.
- Substitutions: Unlimited substitutions on the fly. Player coming off must be within 3 feet of sideline to sub off. Substitutions can only take place in front of the team's bench.
- Every team must have a coach to play the game (exception for Adult Women's division).
- Equipment: Molded cleats, turf shoes and flats (including black-soled) are acceptable footwear. Metal studs cleats are prohibited. **All players must wear shin guards.**
- Duration of Play: 2 x 12 minute halves, 1 minute half time.
- Kickoff: On the whistle, ball may be played in any direction on the first touch (players can score directly from kickoffs). Teams listed first will have the kick-off in the first half.
- Five Second Restart Rule:
 - A restart must occur within 5 seconds of placing the ball for a free kick, corner kick or goal kick.
 - Goalkeepers must also release within 5 seconds after gaining possession and returning to their feet.
- Slide Tackling: Slide tackling the ball by field players is not permitted. If penalized, an indirect free kick will be awarded to the opposing team (unless tackle includes a contact foul on another player)
- Injuries: Any player who is bleeding must leave the field. Time will not be stopped for injuries.
- No added time unless refs feel time is purposely being wasted or for excessively long injuries.
- Goalkeeper Release: Punts and drop kicks are **NOT** permitted. The ball must be distributed by a throw, normal place kick or kick from a dribble (Keeper must take at least 1 touch with their feet before distributing from dribble). If penalized, an indirect free kick will be awarded to the opposing team outside the penalty area.
- Direct and Indirect Free Kicks: Opposing players must give **5 Yards** on all kicks and corner kicks or may be cautioned (Rekick).
- U-11 group is not allowed to intentionally head the ball. Restart is an indirect kick.
- Misconduct Rules:
 - YELLOW: 2 minute penalty for this offense but can be replaced on the field. If a player receives 2 yellow cards in one game or 3 yellow cards throughout the day they will be disqualified from the remainder of the tournament.
 - Red: Ejection without replacement for the duration of match. Any player who receives a red card will be disqualified from the remainder of the tournament. The team will play down a player for the remainder of the game.
 - Coaches can be issued cards and their team will play short one player for the required time.
 - There is a "Zero Tolerance Policy" towards fighting. Any player engaged in fighting will be suspended for the remainder of the tournament without refund.
- **All other FIFA Laws apply.**
- At the end of a round robin play to determine placement, team tiebreakers will consist of (in this order): head to head, goal differential (max 5), fewer goals allowed, goals scored (max 7 per game counted), PK shootout (best of 3, and then 1 per team until a winner is declared, teams will be drawn from a hat and the first name drawn will shoot first).
- Three team tiebreaker rules skip head to head and go straight to goal differential (max 5), fewer goals allowed, goals scored (max 7 per game counted), PK shootout (if down to 2 teams)
- In playoffs, teams tied at the end of regulation will go to a shootout, beginning with 3 shooters each. If it is still tied past 3 teams will go one shooter for each team until there is a winner.
- Point System: **Win=3 Tie=1 Loss=0**
- Referee's calls are final. Anyone who verbally abuses or physically assaults any referee will be removed from the premises.
- Please tell all parents there will be a \$2 parking fee.
- No Grills or anything that causes an open flame. (pop-up canopy's are allowed but not over the benches during games, It puts them too close to the sidelines and can make it unsafe)
- Concession stand will be open all day and is located between our 3 fields (restrooms are also located on the back side of the same building).
- First aid supplies can be found at the concession stand or at the registration table.
- **No Pets** of any kind are permitted within the fence line of the complex.
